Cheraw WWTP & Sewer Collection System Improvements

Cheraw, SC

Construction of upgrades and improvements to the Carolinas Centre Industrial Park and Town of Cheraw sewer collection systems is being financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CW SRF) and the Rural Infrastructure Authority (RIA). The CW SRF program is administered by the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control with joint funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the State of South Carolina. This project consists of the installation of approximately 1,680 linear feet of 15" gravity sewer, 1,430 linear feet of 12" gravity sewer, 800 linear feet of 10" gravity sewer and Upgrades to Pump Station B within the Carolinas Centre Industrial Park. Additionally, Pump Station C will be upgraded to approximately 1,800 gallons per minute with stand-by power, and existing sewer will be replaced with approximately 5,300 linear feet of 24" and 11,400 linear feet of 21" gravity sewer north of the Town of Cheraw. This project will replace old and deteriorated pipe with larger new PVC pipe to provide more reliable & higher sewer flow capacities. Therefore, furthering the possibility of future expansion for community residents and businesses in and near the Town of Cheraw while improving the water quality of Robeson Branch, Huckleberry Branch and the Great Pee Dee River. CW SRF programs operate around the country to provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our valuable water resources.
