Town of Cheraw Infrastructure Improvements

The Town of Cheraw, in coordination with the South Carolina Office of Resilience (SCOR), is in the process of advancing plans for drainage improvements serving the Town of Cheraw through the design and future construction of the Second Street Drainage Improvements project and the Washington & Railroad Drainage Improvements project. These two projects are funded through CDBG-MIT grants administered by SCOR.

Second Street (OSE #D30-N0-MJ-A)

The Town of Cheraw and SCOR are working to upgrade existing drainage along Second Street in downtown Cheraw. These improvements are intended to relieve flooding along Second Street, particularly in the vicinity of the Cheraw Community Center and the Powe Street intersection.

Washington & Railroad (OSE #D30-N0160-MJ-B)

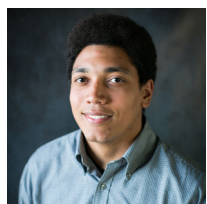
The Town of Cheraw and SCOR are working to improve drainage in the historic Tanyard Ditch watershed. Improvements are planned for the existing drainage system along Front Street and Church Street to the intersection with Second Street. New drainage is planned to be installed along Church Street, Second Street, Third Street, Greene Street, and Market Street and will support the decommissioning and abandonment of existing drainage routed underneath several buildings.
